Flagler County Road Trip 6-23-2007

1. NORTHERN GROUP:

Come south on either I-95 or US-1 to south of St Augustine.

If using I-95 come south to the exit sign "Bunnell" and US-1, veering to the right for approximately 1 mile, looking left for the Old Dixie Hwy.

If using US-1 come south through St Augustine till you come to the junction of I-95, passing under the overpass. Continuing south for approximately 1 mile, looking left for the Old Dixie Hwy.

c. Meeting at 1030am.

2. WEST SIDE GROUP:

Meet at the McDonalds off Orange Camp Road or which ever place is best for your group. Meeting at 0900am and departing by 0930am, using SR-11 to Bunnell. At the junction of US-1 proceed north approximately 20 miles, to arrive at North Old Dixie Hwy by 1030am.

3. EAST SIDE GROUP:

Use US-1 traveling through Bunnell proceeding north approximately 20 miles to arrive at the Old Dixie Hwy by 1030am.

4. ROUTE DIRECTIONS:

a. We will proceed south on Old Dixie Hwy to Princes Place. This will be on a dirt road, but it is well kept.

After looking around and possible tour we will return to Old Kings Rd, turn left, on to US-1 heading south for approximately 18 miles.

Turning right on to CR-13, I will show everyone the old brick road that is now on the National Registry of Historic Sites.

We will then proceed to SR-100 turning right toward Palatka.

Looking for CR-305, turn left.

Continue on CR305 to the junction of CR-304, turn left

Continue to the junction of SR-11, turn left heading to Bunnell.

Cross over the rail road tracks. Cross over US-1 and turning right just before the Court House. Lunch will be at a local eatery called the Bantam Chef. They are noted for their Fish Sandwich. But the do have many other items, i.e., burgers hot dogs, Chicken Wings.

After lunch, I am in the process of trying to get a tour of the Holden House in Bunnell. This is the Flagler County Historical Society Museum.
