New Resources

I have found two resources for information on our cars. The first is the **Heritage Motor Centre** in Great Britain. They have almost all of the records from British carmakers. From their records you can order a certificate detailing the date your car was manufactured, to which dealer it was delivered, the original color, interior, and serial numbers of the engine, transmission, body, and differential.

The Certificate costs £56.00, which at today's exchange rate, is about \$112.00. You can order online using Visa, Master Card, etc. and they will handle all of the conversions. Owner's Manuals

The other resource is a Web site where you can order original owner's manuals. It stocks over 40,000 manuals for cars, trucks, motorcycles, collectibles, you name it.
