VINCO Triumph Transmission FAQ's

Often asked of Vinco Transmission:

Q, What happens when I engage overdrive?

A: The rpm of the transmission output flange is increased in relation to engine rpm. On overdrive engagement earlier TRs with an A-type overdrive (TR3,4,250,6) or the D-type (Spitfire) have a 22% reduction in engine revs, the later cars with a J-type overdrive get a 25% reduction all the while maintaining the same road speed.

The reduction change for your Laycock de Normanville overdrive is the first pair of numbers found on the aluminum serial number plate located on the overdrive unit.
