LED Brake Light Addition by Lance Brazil

Our LBCs are all antiques and do not have a lot of the most modern safety devices. Brake lights on these cars were minimal at best; some worse than that. I wanted to make my car more visible, especially at night so I created a method of adding an LED strip to augment the existing lights. I am not a fan of cutting into the original wiring harness. Using the method below the car can be brought back to the way it was manufactured without buying a whole new wiring harness.

Auto Zone and other auto parts stores have strips of LEDs in various colors and lengths from 8" to 24." They are around \$30 or less and have a peel away backing with strong adhesive to adhere to almost any surface and can be trimmed to shorten.

For this project I used red since that is the standard color for brake lights. I wanted the lights to be unobtrusive but highly visible. I installed them above the regular tail lights and trimmed them to the length of the lights.

Parts

- 14-16 Gauge wire
- Male and female crimp on connectors (3/16") available at Radio Shack
- LED strips available at Auto Zone and other auto parts stores
- Heat shrink tubing (optional)

Procedure for one side


1. Create the pigtail shown below using the crimp on connectors and two short lengths of wire. If you are using heat shrink tubing (available at Home Depot) be sure to slip it over the wires before adding the connectors.



- 2. Locate the wiring for the brake lights. On most British cars of this era the brake light wire is green with purple markings. If you are unsure, download a wiring diagram for your car from http://www.advanceautowire.com. These diagrams are especially helpful because they are printed color-coded for your car. I downloaded mine and had it blown up to 11X17" and laminated.
- 3. Unplug the wiring harness lead from the brake light.

- 4. Insert the pigtail between the wiring harness and the brake light. The bare lead will be used to connect the LED strip. LEDs are polarized. You can verify which lead goes to the brake light and which goes to ground using a standard 9 volt battery.
- 5. Connect the positive lead of the LED strip to the bare wire on the pigtail and the negative lead of the LED strip to a good ground.

The only thing left is to feed the LED strip out of the boot and fasten it to the back of the car. I removed the tail light assembly and fed the LED wires through the bottom of the opening between the body and the gasket. This protects the wiring and has less chance of water getting past the gasket. You can shorten the LED strip by cutting between LEDs.






BRITISH CAR CLASSIC XXVIII
